Dear Parents / Guardians

I am restating the Victorian Government directive as stated in the letter sent yesterday:

All children who can learn from home must learn from home.

In order to protect the health and safety of your children, your family, your teachers, and the whole community, it is important you follow the Victorian Government's direction and keep your child learning at home. ***On-site school attendance is available as a last resort.***

The school has limited capacity to supervise students at school, as teachers have been directed to work from home. As the number of students increase, the greater potential safety and health risk for both students and teachers.

The '**On-site Attendance Form,**' attached **MUST** be completed for next week Monday 20th-Friday 24th April, and returned to the school office by this Friday 17th April, by 3.30pm. We will not be accepting students next week without this form being completed by this Friday, as I need to prepare staffing for the supervision. Thank you for your co-operation in this.
