Dear Parents,

A further update from the school.

**Teachers will be contacting parents between Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup>- Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April by phone, to touch base with you about the remote and flexible learning arrangements for this term.** This is an opportunity to discuss how your child is prepared for the remote learning, as well as, how they are managing in this different learning environment.

If your child does not have their password for either Google Classroom (Prep-Grade 3) or Microsoft Teams (Grades 4-6), please ask the teacher when they contact you.

Please contact the school office for these:

- A hard copy of learning tasks for your grade level, if your child is not doing the remote learning.
- If you wish to obtain a loan device. These will be available for pick up from next Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April. There will be a 'Loan Device Agreement' form to complete for this, which will be sent via email to parents later this week, with further instructions.

For students attending on-site learning, you must complete the '**on-site attendance form,**' for the school, as required by the Department of Education. Students will need to attend in school uniform and have their snack/lunch.

Please note, *"All students who can learn at home must learn from home. This is a very clear directive by the Victorian Government based on the advice of the Chief Health Officer. All students will be learning from home, except for children on days when they are not able to be supervised at home and no other arrangements can be made."*

A further communication to parents will be sent out at the end of this week, which will outline in more detail, how the remote and flexible learning arrangements will be done from next Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April.
