



Remote and Flexible Learning commences Monday 20th July

Dear Parents / Guardians

A few reminders from next Monday 20th July:

Students who can learn from home must do so. Remote and flexible learning commences on Monday 20th July.

The school will resume the learning program using Google Classroom for Prep - Grade 3, and Microsoft Teams for Grade 4 - 6. The school website will continue to be a source of information, including weekly planners of learning tasks for students who do not have access to a computer/internet, or parents who elect this. Scroll down to find the link to the page of home learning.

Loan devices of iPads and laptops. These will be available for collection from the school canteen from this Thursday. (same times as for book pack collection)

Book packs: If book packs were not collected, they are available on Tuesday 21st July, from your child's classroom between 10.00-11.00am and 11.30am- 1.00pm.

On-site supervision

On-site school supervision is offered in certain circumstances, including where students have parents as essential workers, and no other arrangements for home learning can be made. For on-site supervision, parents must complete the [onsite attendance form](#), and give to the office by the Friday prior to the following week.

All students on-site will have their temperature checked on arrival.

The entry will be at the GYM GATE, from 8.45am- 9.15am.

Please be patient as we need to mark students present and conduct the checks.

If students are unwell they must not attend.

If your child is collected throughout the day, they should not return back to school.
