



Principal's Update: Monday 3rd August 2020

Dear Parents / Guardians,

The Victorian Government announced that, on the advice of the Victorian Chief Health Officer, metropolitan Melbourne will move to Stage 4 restrictions to slow the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19).

Please note the following key points:

- Tomorrow, Tuesday 4th August is a Curriculum Day. This is a pupil-free day. No on-site supervision is available. Remote learning will not occur. Students must continue to learn from home. The school will continue to support students through the remote and flexible learning arrangements in place.
- On-site supervision from Wednesday 5th August. Is now only offered to the 2 categories:
 - **Vulnerable Student Category.** These students have been identified by the school and are being contacted by the Assistant Principals (Marg Sheppard and Meagan Donaldson) to see if the on-site supervision is required.
 - **Permitted Workers Category.** The Victorian Government will provide advice on this.
- Teachers and staff are now required to work from home. I will provide staff on-site to only supervise the on-site students.
- **Loan Devices (iPads/laptops).** We are preparing more of these, and they will be available from the school office tomorrow. Go to [ICT agreement](#) to download the agreement form.
- The Curriculum Day planned for next Monday 10th August is now cancelled.

These new guidelines are likely to continue until the end of term 3.

I will provide you further information as it becomes known to me.
