Dear Parents / Guardians

An update on things this week.

Feedback so far indicates the remote learning is working well in most instances. Teachers may send you a feedback survey to complete, which helps us to deliver a program which meets our student learning needs. From next week, specialist teachers will be uploading learning tasks for students. Teachers may be using video live chat to occasionally communicate with students through Google Meet or Microsoft Teams. Please note these will be recorded by the teachers for record-keeping purposes only. We hope this will further facilitate the learning, as well as, provide wellbeing support and social interaction for students.

Teachers may now be using a separate email to communicate with parents, enabling two-way communication. This will be initiated by the teacher.

Loan devices continue to be distributed to parents. So far, 80 devices have been provided and this continues daily. See below for more information.
